Date and Genre of work:						
Write sentences that are sequenced to form a short narrative (real or fictional)						
Demarcate some sentences with capital letters and full stops						
Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling some words correctly and making plausible attempts at others						
Spell some common exception words (at least 1/3 of the CEW used)						
Form lower case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place						
Form lower case letters of the correct size relative to one another in some of their writing						
Use spacing between words						
Working at the Expected Standard						
Demarcate most sentences in their writing with capital letters and full stops						
Use some question appropriately						
Use some exclamation marks appropriately						
Use capital letters for most names and personal pronouns						
Use of the word 'and' to connect words and phrases						
Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling many of these words correctly and making phonically-plausible attempts at others						
Form capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower-case letters						
Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters						
Exceeding the Expected Standard						
Write simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real or fiction)						
Write about real events, recording these simply and clearly
