## Top Tips for your child to play games safely online:

- 1. Check your child has a safe username (e.g. doesn't contain their own, full name).
- 2. Check what your child is sharing is safe (e.g. no personal details or information).
- 3. Regularly check and talk to your child about who they are playing with online.
- 4. Check your child's privacy settings.
- 5. Ensure your child takes regular breaks.
- 6. Regularly check for adverts or in app/game purchases.
