










Autumn 1 Book Study

On our website you can find our **Big Idea knowledge organisers** which includes weekly **optional homework**. These will also be sent home in homework books. We encourage the children to bring a collection of their homework into school to share and we will always make time to celebrate the children's hard work!

Fluency homework will also be given on a **Friday**; this will include a spelling rule and focus times table. The children will then be tested on these the **following Friday**.

These tests will be recorded in the back of their homework books for you to see at home.



Reading

The children will be given a levelled reading book and a reading bookmark by their teacher (coming soon).

These need to come into school every morning and they need to go home every night.

Children must read 4 times a week.

Multiplication Check. You can find more information about this using the link attached:




Please make sure your child has their own water bottle to bring to school with them everyday. We encourage that these bottles are named and taken home to wash frequently.
