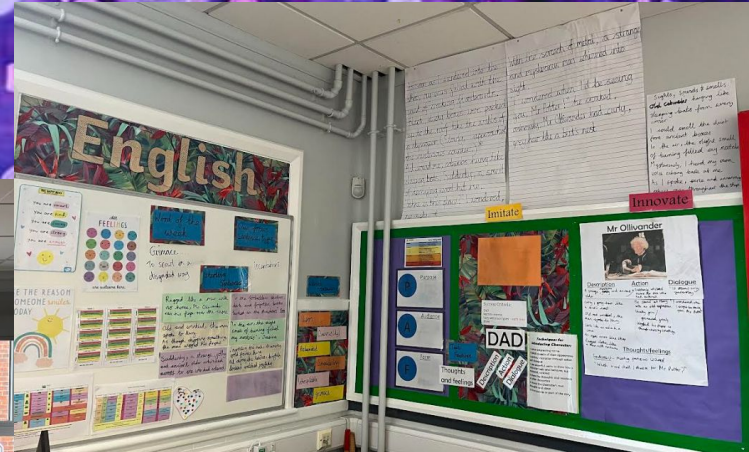

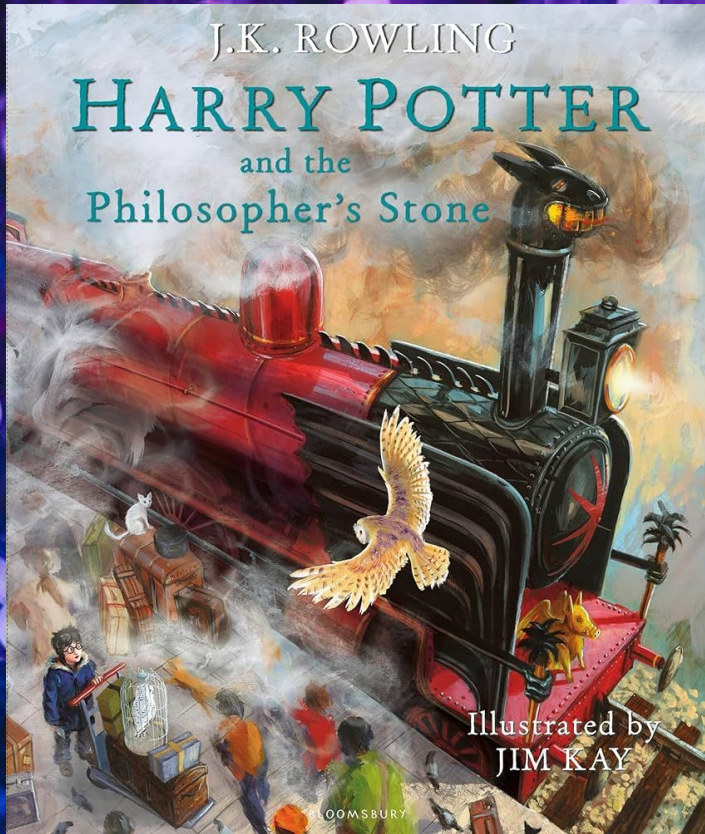

Fluency homework will also be given on a **Friday**; this will include a spelling rule and focus times table. The children will then be tested on these the **following Friday**.

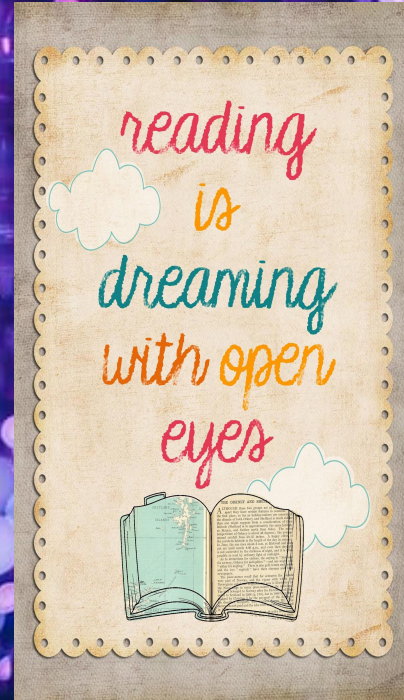
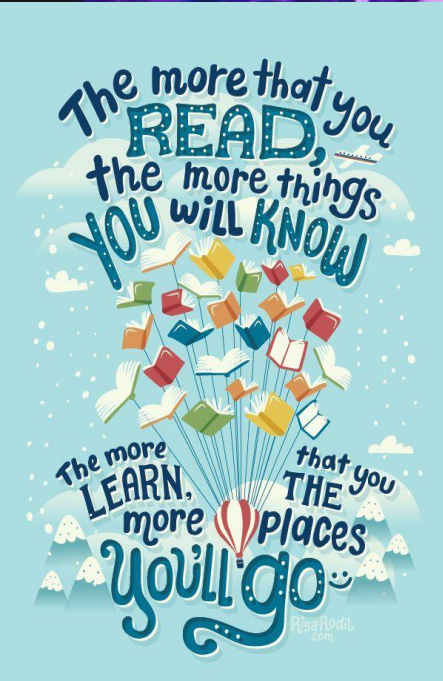
These tests will be recorded in the back of their homework books for you to see at home.
