In addition, we enjoy incoporating drama lessons into Writing lessons to help the children to emerge themselves in the text and sometimes pop themselves in the shoes of a character/ perspective.

#### Sentence Types

Different year groups focus on different sentence types, gradually building on the knowledge they've acquired from lower down in school.

# Spelling

#### Common Exception Words

In Year 3, we revise the Common Exception Words for Year 1/2.

Then, advance to learning the Common Exception Words for Year 3/4.

We also focus on teaching specific spelling rules each week.



Later in the year, the children will begin to use Spelling Shed to help them with the learning of specific spellings and rules.

There will be 6 spellings in the Friday quiz. If it's a specific spelling rule then the children will learn the rule for their homework and can be tested on any word that follows that rule. If it isn't a rule, then 6 specific spellings will be given to the children to learn.

## Maths

By the end of Year 3, your child is expected to know their 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 8x and 10x tables.

We will use Number Gym and TT Rockstars to support your child's learning of these (alongside normal class teaching).

We may also use My Maths that will aid your child's learning at home.

During the first half term, our focus will be on place value and adding and subtracting numbers.

Each classroom has a Learning Journey; each of our Big Ideas will be displayed on here. This half-term, Year 3 are doing a book study on Alice in Wonderland.


#### What happens when?
