

Where and what is Carlton Lodge?

- Carlton Lodge is a residential school trip which will take place between **Wednesday 21st May - Friday 23rd May 2025**.
- The residential trip forms part of your child's Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) and Physical Education.

Travel Arrangements

- Children will arrive at the usual time on Wednesday. We leave at approximately 11am, so we will arrive at Carlton Lodge for 12 noon. Please feel free to come and wave your child off. Children do not need to come in school uniform on that day. Times may be subject to change but you will be informed of any changes immediately.
- Children will need a packed lunch for Wednesday - to eat upon arrival.
- We should arrive back on Friday between 2:00 - 2:30pm. You can either collect your child at this time or wait until 3:25pm as normal.

Medicine

- All medication (including travel sickness medication) must be given to Miss Ward upon arrival at school on Wednesday with a medication form (this should have been completed ahead of the residential).
- Children who hold a Health Care Plan in school must have their medication checked by a parent before the trip to ensure it is in date.
- Travel Sickness - Tablets will be looked after by a teacher while we are away. Please inform staff so they can sit near the front of the coach/mini bus. Please ensure there are enough tablets for additional trips to bouldering and gorge walking during the residential .

Technology



No technology is to be brought on the residential.

The days will be jam-packed and activities will take place through the night (up until bedtime that is!)

Food

Breakfast, lunch and tea/dinner will all be catered for.

Breakfast - choice of cold/hot breakfasts available.

Lunch - packed lunch (sandwiches, crisps, fruit etc).

Tea/dinner - various homemade hot food.

All children and dietary requirements will be catered for!

Groups

- Group arrangements will be decided nearer the time - there will be 6 groups with approximately 10 children in each.
- Each child will have a say in what group they are in.
- All children will have completed the 'Code of Conduct' to ensure everyone stays safe!

Sleeping Arrangements
