Historical Key Information:

This Big Idea's host subject is History. The children will work towards understanding who the Anglo-Saxons and the Scots were, why they invaded England and Scotland and who were the most important people in this time period.

- The Anglo-Saxons were made up of 3 tribes: Angles, Saxons and Jutes.
- They settled in Britain around 450AD.
- They came from Germany, Denmark and the Netherlands.
- They lived in wooden thatched houses.
- Many that came over were farmers and they all ate a varied diet.

The Anglo-Saxon Alphabet:



Anglo-Saxon runes were symbols used by the Anglo-Saxons as an alphabet in their writing system. All runes were known collectively as *futhorc* in Old English. Can you write your name using the Anglo-Saxon runes?
